

## **Weekend Brings 2 More Wins**

In Saturday's opening game of the three game series, Aaron West got the start for the Tigers. West threw his 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive complete game to collect his 8<sup>th</sup> win of the season. In the rubber game, Coach Hemmings sent Jimmy Lamourt to the mound in an all important, must win for the Tigers. Lamourt, who has been steady all year, gave the Tigers a solid performance, giving way to Kenny Faulk in the sixth. Faulk was even more dominant than Lamourt going 5 innings of his own and striking out 5 without allowing a run. Andrew used a three run third inning to take an early lead, but found themselves in another tight, extra inning game. This time the Tigers took care of business in the tenth. Adam Fuller tripled home Randy Williams for the Tigers 2<sup>nd</sup> walk off win in one weekend. The Tigers host Gordon College next weekend to round out the regular season.
