

Tigers Run Win Total to 24

Jimmy Lamourt got the start on the mound for the Tigers and took advantage with a strong performance, and his second win of the season. Lamourt threw 5 innings, striking out 5 while only allowing three hits. Terry Nash followed up with 2 dominant innings out of the pen, using only 15 pitches to get the final 6 outs. The second shutout in consecutive days ran the pitching staff's scoreless streak to 16 innings. At the plate the Tigers were equally impressive. Schley Eldridge led the way with his bat going 3 for 5 with 5 runs batted in. Not far behind was Ric Bishop who added 3 hits and 2 runs scored. Jud Jones, Jay Barefield, and Joe Sutton all added 2 hits each.

Game 2 proved to be a tougher contest. Jim Reynolds toed the rubber for the Tigers and was not real sharp. Reynolds struggled through 3 innings, allowing 2 runs to score. Rad Mitchell and Chase Hargraves followed up Reynolds performance and were a little inconsistent in the strike zone. Hargraves worked the sixth, allowing the tying run to cross the plate, but ended up the eventual winner of the ballgame. In the bottom of the seventh the Tigers tacked on three more runs to take the lead. Chris McKenna came in to get the final three outs, but was only able to get two of them. Terry Nash came in to record the final out and earn his first collegiate save. Offensively Zach Martin collected 3 hits and Seth Reber had 2 hits and 3 runs batted in. Both of Reber's run scoring hits gave the Tigers the lead. Andrew College heads into their bye weekend with an overall record of 24-15.
