

## **Streak Ends; Tigers Win Game 2**

The Tigers were unable to keep their six game winning streak alive on Tuesday afternoon. Jacob Watson got the start for Andrew and only allowed two earned runs over 5 strong innings of work. The Andrew College offense could never get its rhythm as the Central Alabama pitching staff kept the Tigers guessing at the plate. Brian Stewart and Zach Martin each added two hits in the game. Jud Jones picked up the Tigers lone run on a sacrifice fly in the second inning that scored Brian Stewart from third base.

Game two was a different story as Andrew stormed out of the gates with a five run first inning. Merit Hicks cleared the bases with a 3 run double to highlight the big inning for the Tigers. RM Cozza earned his second win of the season going 5 innings and only allowing three hits. Brian Stewart and Zach Martin again led the offensive charge as each added two more hits. Stewart slammed his first home run as a Tiger, hitting a 2-0 pitch through the wind, and over the right centerfield wall. Beau Burnette and Jimmy Lamourt pitched the final two innings to secure the Tigers second shutout of the season. The Tigers host nationally ranked Gulf Coast on Sunday, at 1:00 PM, in a scheduled doubleheader.
