

Tigers Win Fourth Straight

Jacob Watson provided the Tigers with his best start of the season on Sunday in game 1. Watson cruised for 6 innings en route to his first win of the 2007 season. 3 hits was all the Weevils offense could muster against Watson who used 4 different pitches to keep their hitters confused. In the first inning Adam Fuller scored from third on a ground ball by Zach Martin to get the Tigers on the board. In the fifth Schley Eldridge led off the inning with a hit by pitch and later scored on a single by Ric Bishop. The Andrew College offense had 9 hits on the day, and were led by Adam Fuller, Ric Bishop, and Merit Hicks who all added 2 hits. Chris McKenna earned his second save of the season recording the final 3 outs of the game.

In game 2, RM Cozza toed the rubber for his 2nd start of the season. Cozza struck out three in 5 innings of work to earn his first win in a Tigers uniform. Coach Hemmings used a different lineup, placing Casey Townsend in the leadoff spot. Townsend capitalized on the move, pacing the Tigers with 3 hits, 1 run scored, and an RBI. In the third inning Andrew scored 4 runs using back to back two out hits by Zach Martin and Brian Stewart. In the sixth, Andrew added an insurance run when Jay Barefield scored all the way from first base on a double by Casey Townsend. Chris McKenna recorded the final 5 outs of the game in 16 pitches to pick up his second save on the day, and third save this season.

The Tigers go back into action on Tuesday as they host Okaloosa-Walton in a 9 inning contest scheduled for a 1:00 PM start.
