

Tigers Snap Streak

Game 1 got off to a promising start for the Tigers on Friday night. Jacob Watson, who got the start on the mound, gave the Tigers a chance to pick up a win in the opening game of the series. The Tigers got on the board in the 1st when Adam Fuller came around to score on a single by clean up hitter Brian Stewart. In the 4th the Tigers added 2 more runs using a two out single by Randy Williams to take a 3-1 lead. In the 5th the Tigers added one more when back to back doubles by Adam Fuller and Ric Bishop gave Andrew their biggest lead of the game at 4-1. Watson, who was cruising, ran into some trouble in the 6th. South Georgia scored 4 times on one hit and two sacrifices to take the lead. South Georgia added to their lead in the 7th, getting their sixth and final run.

The Tigers found themselves in an early hole in game 2. Tigers' starter Aaron West could not get out of the first inning, surrendering 5 runs. The first 5 batters West faced reached on hits and West would not make it into the 2nd inning. The Tigers offense did all they could do to take the lead but stranded runners in the 2nd, 6th, and 7th innings. Joe Sutton, Adam Fuller, Zach Martin, and Casey Townsend all collected 2 hits apiece. RM Cozza, who came in relief of Aaron West, gave the Tigers his best performance of the season. Cozza went 4 1/3 innings, only allowing 1 run on 4 hits.

The Tigers finally got the monkey off their back in game 3. The Tigers could not afford the sweep on Saturday and answered with a hard fought win. The Tigers scored first, getting three runs in the 3rd, using four singles. South Georgia answered back with 4 runs in their half of the third. Tigers' starter Kenny Faulk worked into the 5th before giving way to Beau Burnette. Burnette worked 1 2/3 innings of relief facing the minimum 5 batters. Chris McKenna locked up his fifth save of the season, striking out the final two batters of the game. Andrew will host Tallahassee Community College on Tuesday at 3:00 PM.
