Andrew College's Neida Soto of Marietta, GA and Jessica Shearon of Sharpsburg, GA were named Academic All-American by the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA). To be eligible for this recognition, a student must have at least a 3.6 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
