

Albany State University and Andrew College Presidents sign articulation agreement

The presidents of Andrew College and Albany State University signed a document that will make it easier for students who earn an associate degree in business administration at Andrew College to transition seamlessly into one of six bachelor's degree majors at Albany State University.

Dr. David Seyle, Andrew College president, and Dr. Everette J. Freeman, ASU president, signed the articulation agreement during a ceremony held Thursday, October 22, at 11 a.m. in the President's Dining Hall on the ASU campus.

"We are delighted to establish this relationship with Andrew College," Freeman said. "Andrew College has a reputation as an outstanding two-year college whose graduates are well-prepared to continue their education beyond the associate degree. We look forward to helping these students realize their potential at Albany State."



Dr. David Seyle, Andrew College president, stated, "The partnership with Albany State is a bridge to a bachelor's degree that will encourage Andrew College students by providing a seamless transition into the Albany State business programs."

Under the agreement, the ASU Bachelor of Science degree in a business major is open to Andrew College graduates with an associate degree in business administration and a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.25. Six ASU business majors are available: business management, healthcare management, accounting, business information systems, marketing, and supply chain and logistics management.

"The College of Business is excited and very enthusiastic about our new relationship with Andrew College," said Dr. Jonathan Jefferson, dean of the ASU College of Business. "This articulation agreement provides Andrew College students the opportunity to pursue bachelor's degrees in business while helping the College of Business increase its enrollment. We look forward to a long and mutually beneficial partnership as we continue to prepare academically qualified business professionals for the global economy."

Located in Cuthbert, Ga., Andrew College is a private two-year liberal arts college related to the United Methodist Church. Andrew College's current enrollment is about 230 students.
