The goal of this collaboration is to provide Associate of Applied Science (AAS) graduates of select ATC programs with an opportunity to enroll with Andrew College and earn their bachelor's degree. ATC graduates in accounting, business technology, business management, and marketing management, will have the opportunity to transfer to Andrew College to earn a Bachelor of Science (BS) in Business Administration.
