### **Andrew College professor accepted into summer fellowship program**

CUTHBERT, GA. – Assistant Professor of History Charles Roberts, has been accepted into The Governor’s Teaching Fellows Program. This program, established in 1995 by then-Governor Zell Miller, provides Georgia’s higher education faculty with expanded opportunities for developing important teaching skills.

Andrew College President Linda R. Buchanan, remarked that the fellowship program is very competitive and that she is extremely pleased that Professor Roberts was selected to be part of the highly-respected program. She said, “Professor Roberts will represent Andrew College in the finest light, and I look forward to hearing of his learning opportunities following his return from the symposium.”

As a Governor’s Teaching Fellow, Roberts will be attending an intensive two-week summer symposium which includes a combination of activities, including faculty development, instructional activities, and independent study. The program is offered through the Institute of Higher Education at the University of Georgia.

Roberts is in his second year of teaching history at Andrew College, serves as the Honors Program coordinator and is a co-advisor for the Theta Lambda Chapter of Phi Theta Kappa.
