Andrew College Convocation open to the public

CUTHBERT, GA. – Andrew College officially launches the new academic year on its campus Thursday, August 24 with an opening convocation ceremony at 11 a.m. in the G. Clyde and Ruth Tarrer Jinks, Sr. Physical Education Complex. This ceremony marks the College’s 164th academic year since its founding in 1854.

Interim Dean for Academic Affairs Richard McCallum will deliver the keynote address. After receiving his Ph.D. from the University of Nebraska in Lincoln, he maintained a dual career for more than three decades—one in higher education and the other in the Army National Guard. During these years, he worked at universities in four different states and completed more than 30 years of military service that included nine years of active duty as an Infantry Officer. These Army tours involved deployment during the Gulf War and assignments at the Pentagon, Fort Monroe and the Army War College.

The convocation ceremony is open to all Andrew College students and members of the community are encouraged to attend.
