CUTHBERT, GA. –AndrewServes, a student leadership program at Andrew College in Cuthbert, will host their 4th Annual Mission 22 Walk for Veteran Suicide Awareness and Prevention event on Saturday, Nov. 10. Mission 22 is a non-profit organization that brings awareness to the 22 veterans who commit suicide every day.

The public is invited to participate. As a group, participants will walk 22 miles in solidarity with the Mission 22 movement. Lunch and water will be provided and rides will be given to those who need breaks or who cannot complete the walk.

The van to go to the starting point will be leaving the Old Main building at Andrew College, 501 College Street, Cuthbert at 7:30 a.m. and the walk will begin at 8 a.m. from the Stewart County Health Department at 211 Health Department Road, Lumpkin, GA.

If you are interested in riding as a caravan rather than walking, a group will be leaving from Old Main at 10:00 a.m.

The walk/ride will finish at the Omaha Brewing Company, 265 Brew St., Omaha, GA, who will be hosting a Veteran's Day celebration with live music, food trucks, specials and games.
