CUTHBERT, GA. – In conjunction with Black History Month, Andrew College held a Martin Luther King, Jr. celebration on February 15 in the Jones Chapel. Included in the ceremony, was an essay reading by Patrick Kabuye, a sophomore student from Germany. Kabuye read his winning essay that he wrote for a competition that was held as part of Black History Month activities on campus.
