Andrew College Nursing program passes another accreditation hurdle

CUTHBERT, GA. – The Andrew College Nursing Division received notification on March 6, 2018 that the Associate Degree Nursing Program has been granted NLN CNEA pre-accreditation status as follows:

"The Andrew College, Associate Degree Nursing Program holds pre-accreditation status from the National League for Nursing Commission for Nursing Education Accreditation, located at 2600 Virginia Avenue, NW, Washington, DC, 20037. Holding pre-accreditation status does not guarantee that initial accreditation by NLN CNEA will be received."

Programs holding NLN CNEA pre-accreditation status are eligible to apply for initial program accreditation with NLN CNEA. Pre-accreditation status is effective for three years.

Susan Askew, director of the nursing program, remarked that receiving the pre-accreditation status was highly desired. "Andrew College continues to work hard in order to offer relevant and needed degree programs to the southwest region of Georgia. "
