CUTHBERT, GA. – Personnel changes at Andrew College have been announced, effective January 1. Karan Pittman, Benevolence, has been promoted to the position of assistant academic dean, and McKenzie M. Ragan has been promoted to the position of director of library services and educational technology coordinator.

In her new role, Professor Pittman will spend 50% of her time with academic affairs providing leadership for retention efforts and supervising the Student Success Center (SSC) and Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP). The other half of her time will be invested in alumni projects and the college's archives.

Karan Pittman received her Master of Science degree in library science from the University of North Carolina, her Bachelor of Science degree in secondary social science education from Auburn University and her Associate of Arts degree in humanities from Andrew College.

Since 1990, Professor Pittman has served as Andrew College's director of library services and has taught numerous classes. She is also an author and historian.

As director of library services, McKenzie M. Ragan, Shellman, will now provide the leadership for the Pitts Library. She will also continue to support the technology needs for online courses.

Assistant Professor Ragan received her Master of Library and Information Science degree from Valdosta State University and her Bachelor of Arts degree in English from the University of Georgia.

Assistant Professor Ragan previously served as assistant librarian and college store manager.
