Andrew College invites the public to the play, *The Diviners*

CUTHBERT, GA. – Andrew College invites the community to the always-incredible journey of live theatre. Jim Leonard Jr.'s captivating story, *The Diviners*, will be presented at Andrew College in Cuthbert, Thursday-Saturday, November 3-5 at 7 p.m. and on Sunday, November 6 at 2 p.m. in the Liddie Murphy Theatre in Old Main. The show is presented by Andrew College students with direction by Nate Gross, assistant professor of theatre.

Winner of the American College Theatre Festival, the tragic drama is set during the Great Depression in a tiny Indiana town which searches for purpose, meaning and water. Teenager Buddy has been traumatized by water; he fears it and can sense when it is nearby. Newcomer C. C. Showers finds Buddy after giving up a life of preaching to seek a fresh start. Can water give life to the town of Zion, Indiana? Or will it dry up like the empty, pastor-less church by the river?

The home for Andrew College Theatre is the historic Liddie Murphy Theatre. Seating 175, “The Liddie” has welcomed audiences to Andrew for over 120 years. Recent renovations include LED lighting, a digital soundboard, new curtains, resurfaced floors, and reupholstered and refinished historic seats. Students are trained to use all equipment in theatre classes and in practical production roles.
