Andrew College Writing and Reading Center receives grant

CUTHBERT, GA. – The Interdisciplinary Writing and Reading Center (IWRC) at Andrew College received notice that they received a grant from the Southeast Writing Centers Association for collaborative tutor training. This project partners with the tutoring program of the writing center at Southwest Georgia State University. Research will focus on the best way to train tutors for working with members of the local community. The grant will allow tutors and staff to collaborate and brainstorm on each campus regarding training techniques, resources and best practices. These discussions will be used as a springboard for more in-depth research into tutor training.

Caroline Collins, director of IWRC said, “We are very excited about the prospect of learning from others and using what we learn to better serve the needs of our campus and our local community.”

Besides serving Andrew College students, the IWRC is open to community members. All are encouraged to visit for assistance with any tasks that involve writing and/or reading. This semester the center is open from 1 to 3 p.m. and 6 to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 1 to 3 p.m. Friday, and 7 to 9 p.m. on Sunday. The Center is located in the Pitts Library.
