



Questions and Answers about Residence Life

How do I reserve a private room? At the beginning of the fall semester, every student should expect a roommate. Private rooms will be assigned after the conclusion of the add/drop period to ensure everyone has housing. Students can contact Jaleesa Richardson at jaleesarichardson@andrewcollege.edu if they are interested in a Private Room. Private Rooms are awarded on a first come first serve basis, and the additional private room charge of \$750.00 must be paid before the student is awarded the private room. Students who wish to pay for the private room must contact Mrs. Peggy Moore in the Business Office.

When will I know my room assignment? Room assignments will be completed during the month of July and students will be notified via their Andrew College email accounts.

May I have visitors? Inter-hall visitation is permitted Sunday - Thursday 10:00 a.m. - 10:00 p.m. and Friday - Saturday 12:00 p.m. - 12:00 a.m. At other times, persons of the opposite sex must not enter for any reason. Off campus visitors must sign into ACPD and receive a guest pass and a parking pass. Guest passes must remain with the visitor, and the guest must remain with the Andrew College host at all times during their presence on campus. Off Campus visitors may spend only two nights on campus and must abide by all visitation rules. Andrew College students are responsible for the conduct of their guests while on campus.

Are the halls quiet so I can study in my room? Andrew College has quiet hours that are in effect every night and they are as follows: Sunday - Thursday 9:00 p.m. - 10:00 a.m. and Friday - Saturday 11:00 p.m.- 10:00 a.m. During these hours, all members of the residence hall community are entitled to as few disruptions and distractions as possible. Also, we have what is called “courtesy hours,” in place which means students have the right to reasonable quiet and freedom from unusually loud music or other disruptions in the hall. During exam periods at the end of each semester, a 24-hour quiet period will exist in the residence halls. This period will extend two days prior to the beginning of exams and remain in effect until the last exam.

May I stay on campus during breaks? Students are able to remain on campus is during the following Breaks: Fall Break, Thanksgiving Break, Spring Break and Easter Break. Students must vacate campus during the following breaks; Winter Break (between Fall and Spring Semester) and Summer Break (after the Spring Semester). All students MUST vacate campus on the stated days and times found on the Andrew College website and on your campus closure form. Students who fail to leave campus by the designated time will be charged a fee. Please see the *Andrew College Student Handbook* for more information.

What are an “RA” and an “RD”? An “RA” is a Resident Assistant. These individuals are Andrew College student-employees whom have been hired by the Residence Life Office to help maintain order and safety in the halls as well as to be there for students as they have questions or needs throughout the year. An “RD” is a Resident Director. These individuals live in the residence halls and are employed by

the college to aid in maintaining order and safety in the residence halls and assist students throughout the year. Resident Assistants report to the Resident Directors.

Is there someone available if I have an emergency in the Residence Hall? All residence halls are staffed with one Resident Director and multiple Resident Assistants. If a student needs assistance in the residence halls, he/she may contact the hall RA or RD. All campus Resident Directors have duty days and can be reached on the RD duty phone at 229-310-0266. If an RD cannot be reached, students may also contact the Andrew College Police Department at 229-732-5919.
