General Function

Andrew College is seeking a program director and an assistant professor for forestry. The successful applicant should have a master's degree in Forestry (18 semester hours minimum in Forestry) with an emphasis toward forest industry practices and certifications. This twelve-month position will be responsible for teaching six forestry courses, one of which is an internship. This individual is expected to interact with the community, with industry leaders, and with local schools and extension offices. The successful applicant must be willing to reach out to future students, both traditional and non-traditional.

Minimum Requirements

- A master's degree or Ph. D. in forestry (18 semester hours of forestry) from an accredited institution with an understanding of current forestry practices, certifications, and employment needs is required.
- Ability to meet and interact with industry officials, community leaders, and school counselors and organizations. Experience within the industry preferred.
- Must be authorized for unrestricted employment in the United States indefinitely with no immigration sponsorship needed.

Working Conditions

Office and classroom environment with minimum lifting (25 pounds) required.
Flexible teaching and office hours to include late afternoons and occasional Saturdays.
