General Function

Andrew College is seeking an assistant professor for political science. The successful applicant should have a master's degree in political science (18 semester hours minimum in political science) with an emphasis toward criminal justice and/or legal studies. This ten-month position will be responsible for teaching, both in-class and online, the political science course required of all freshman. Several other courses may be expected, depending on expertise. This individual is expected to interact with the community, with local leaders, and with local schools, when appropriate. The successful applicant must be willing to reach out to future students, both traditional and non-traditional.

Minimum Requirements

- A master's degree or Ph. D. in political science (18 semester hours minimum in political science; Ph. D. preferred) from an accredited institution is required.
- Ability to meet and interact with local officials, community and state leaders, and school counselors and organizations.
- Must be authorized for unrestricted employment in the United States indefinitely with no immigration sponsorship needed.

Working Conditions

Office and classroom environment with minimum lifting (25 pounds) required.
Flexible teaching and office hours to include late afternoons and occasional Saturdays.
