## General Function

Supervise nursing students in clinical setting as appropriate for nursing course.

## Duties and Responsibilities

1. Perform all aspects of clinical preparation and instruction in appropriate clinical setting, simulation laboratory and/or clinical skills practice laboratory.
2. Maintain department guidelines and standards.
3. Create an effective learning environment.
4. Present instruction based on the competencies and performance levels of the course.

## Minimum Requirements

- Master's degree of nursing from a regionally or nationally accredited college or university (may be in progress);
- Unencumbered Registered Nurse licensed in the State of Georgia;
- Current healthcare provider CPR/BLS certification;
- Two years of full-time clinical experience in the area of teaching responsibility;
- Three years teaching experience in nursing within the last seven years preferred;
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills;
- Ability to work a flexible schedule;
- Must be authorized for unrestricted employment in the United States indefinitely with no immigration sponsorship needed.

## Working Conditions

Clinical environment with minimum lifting (25 pounds) required. Flexible hours to include varying clinical setting shifts/schedules.

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
