



Cares Act Grant Reporting

Andrew College signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the institution has used 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students and the other 50% (Institutional Allocation) was also credited to eligible residential student's accounts. All 100% of the this program went to students.

The amount of \$177,936 was received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

The total amount of \$177,936 of the Emergency Financial Aid Grants was distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of June 3, 2020.

There were 210 students who were eligible to participate in the Federal student financial aid programs under Section 484 of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, and thus were eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

The Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act were distributed by check to all 210 students.

Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students were distributed in 2 tiers with 151 Pell eligible students receiving \$950 each and the remaining 59 students receiving \$584.50 each.

Emails was sent to students on June 2, 2020 stating that the grants were being processed.
