

Math Placement Criteria

Students meeting **any** of the criteria on the list below may enroll in MAT111 without the corequisite Learning Support course, MAT099, OR in MAT102.

- HSGPA of 3.4 or higher and completion of the Required High School Curriculum in mathematics
OR
- An ACT Mathematics score of 21 or higher
OR
- An SAT (old) Mathematics score 490 or higher
OR
- An SAT (new) Math section score of 535 or higher
OR
- Classic Accuplacer Elementary Algebra score of 84 or higher
OR
- Accuplacer Next-Generation Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, and Statistics score of 279 or higher

Students meeting **any** of the criteria listed below may enroll in MAT111 & 099.

- HSGPA of 3.2 or higher and completion of the Required High School Curriculum in mathematics.
OR
- An ACT Mathematics score of 19 or higher
OR
- SAT (old) Mathematics score of 420 or higher
OR
- An SAT (new) Math section score of 460 or higher
OR
- Classic Accuplacer Elementary Algebra score of 70 or higher
OR
- Accuplacer Next-Generation Quantitative Reading, Algebra, and Statistics score of 270 or higher.
OR
- Transfer credit

Students not meeting the exemption criteria criteria listed above will be placed in MAT101 (non-STEM majors) OR in MAT091 (STEM majors)

Note: Accuplacer testing is not required but is an option for students who do not meet other exemption criteria. These students must contact the Accuplacer Testing Coordinator at Andrew College to schedule a testing session, or, if they test at another location, must arrange for their scores to be sent to Andrew College. Several testing sessions will be offered at Andrew College during summer, fall, and spring semesters.
