AFFORDABILITY

Andrew College offers a comprehensive financial assistance program, designed to help students afford the cost of college. Traditionally one of the lowest cost private colleges in Georgia, it is our goal to help make Andrew College a realistic option for all students.

The annual cost of Andrew College for 2020-2021 is \$19,172 for tuition and \$11,728 for room and board. Total annual cost is \$30,900.

There are no mandatory fees of any kind.

FINANCIAL AID

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is used to determine financial need
- More than 60% of our students receive Pell Grants
- 100% of eligible students who complete the financial aid process receive institutional aid awards

General Institutional Scholarship Provisions

Students will ordinarily qualify for just one college-administered Primary Scholarship and Aid award. Students may qualify for up to two additional Secondary Scholarship and Aid Awards in addition to the Primary Scholarship and Aid Award.

Additional Financial Assistance

Students who are applying for institutional scholarships must also complete the FAFSA form in a timely manner and list Andrew College as a school to receive the results. **Our FAFSA code is 001545.**
