## Fine and Performing Arts

### Music

The Associate of Music degree (AM) is offered with a vocal, piano, or instrumental emphasis. Music students will take courses in music theory, aural skills, and applied lessons.

Students participating in the music program receive training which allows them to pursue a Bachelor of Music with emphases in performance or music education.

### Theatre

Theatre students are able to be involved in productions beginning as early as their first semester, giving them valuable experience both on stage and behind the scenes.

### Visual Art

The Associate of Arts degree in Visual Art is designed to provide a college level introduction to drawing, painting, color and design, 2-D design, 3-D design, ceramics, art history and photography.

## Honors Program



# Admission


Applying to Andrew College is quick and easy. We prefer that students submit their application electronically through our website, [www.andrewcollege.edu](http://www.andrewcollege.edu), but we also accept paper applications.

## Required Admission Materials

- Completed application for admission
- \$20 application fee
- Official high school transcripts
- SAT and/or ACT scores

## Admission Categories

**SAT or ACT:** scores optional



## Provisional Admission

Students who fall below the criteria for unconditional or conditional admission will be evaluated by the Enrollment Management Committee and will be required to participate in either an in-person or a telephone interview.

## Transfer Admission

Transfer students who have completed at least 24 semester hours of college coursework do not need to submit SAT or ACT scores as a part of the application process. However, official transcripts from all colleges attended must be provided before an admission decision is finalized.




## Reflections on my Andrew journey
