

Curriculum/Coursework

Andrew College offers a two-year Associate Degree in Nursing. Students are required to enter in the Fall semester and take a Summer term in order to complete the program in sequence.

Admission Requirements and Pre-Requisites

- 1. Admission to Andrew College
- 2. Completed nursing application, including supplemental documents and unofficial transcripts from all colleges attended
- 3. Minimum 2.8 college grade point average
- 4. Completion of the following college courses: English Composition I, College Algebra and Introduction to Psychology
- 5. Completion of college Anatomy and Physiology I & II within the last five years with a grade of "C" or higher
- 6. Required Kaplan entrance exam (see https://www.andrewcollege.edu/nursing-application-process/)

Clinicals

Preferred Admission Consideration

Incoming students not meeting the admission and pre-requisite requirements are encouraged to enroll in the Health Science program at Andrew College. Andrew College students successfully completing the pre-requisites and other requirements while maintaining a 2.8 or higher GPA are eligible for preferred admission consideration into the nursing program for the following year. Acceptance is competitive, as seats are limited. Meeting minimal admission requirements does not guarantee acceptance.
