ANDREW MEANS SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE



The Sustainable Agriculture program at Andrew College equips students with the necessary foundation to complete an agricultural bachelor's degree program or move directly into career paths in sustainable agriculture.

Curriculum/Coursework

The program offers a host of courses that cover theoretical as well as practical aspects of agricultural sustainability. Students will learn about the fundamentals of crop and livestock production, farm management and natural resource conservation. Farm visits, internship opportunities and opportunities to engage with the community are promoted to develop practical understanding of agricultural sustainability in the state of Georgia. The program emphasizes social, environmental and economic aspects of alternative food systems and their relationship to soil health.

Agribusiness

Andrew College also offers an Associate degree in Agribusiness, designed for students who may be interested in career opportunities in agricultural business, agricultural product marketing, agricultural finance, farm management and small business management.

Internships

Andrew College currently partners with White Oak Pastures in Bluffton, Georgia, and Konoinia Farm in Americus, Georgia, which both provide unique opportunities for students to participate in 'living-laboratories.' Additional internship opportunities may be available.
