- apply and be admitted to Andrew College

- have a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher



An Opportunity to Lead

You'll enroll in a two-credit hour leadership course each semester while volunteering in the local community.

- Basic Leadership
- Concepts of Servant Leadership
- Communication in Leadership
- Servant Leadership and Power

As a participant in AndrewServes, you'll receive a designation on your transcript as well as a prestigious diploma from Phi Theta Kappa Leadership.

Designated AndrewServes participants are eligible for scholarships up to \$9,500 per year.

The AndrewServes Servant Leadership Program was formed in 2000 to provide service opportunities for students. By serving the community, students gain confidence and self-esteem as they learn how to make a difference in the lives of others.

AndrewServes helps students discover their leadership abilities while making an impact in the community. Retreats, tutoring and volunteering in a community agency of each student's own choosing are just a few of the program components that further enhance students' leadership education and development.

An Opportunity to Serve

AndrewServes provides a multitude of service opportunities such as

- Participating in an Alternative Spring Break Mission Trip with Habitat for Humanity
- Mentoring and tutoring local elementary, middle and high school students
- Hosting events at local nursing homes, shelters, churches and schools
- Organizing the on-campus recycling campaign and Adopt-A-Mile cleanups in partnership with Keep Randolph Beautiful
- Volunteering at area festivals
- Participating in community sponsored events, team building retreats and leadership conferences
