



Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act, 2021 (CRRSAA)

Andrew College received a second round of funding from the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA). CRRSAA requires that an institution receiving funding provide the same amount in financial aid grants to student from the new CRRSAA funds that it was required to provide under its original CARES Act Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students, Section 18004(a)(1). An Institutional portion from the CRRSAA was allocated by the HEERF II.

The amount of \$177,936 was received from the Department for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

The amount of \$439,380 has been allocated under Section 18004(a)(1) and \$26,675 under Section 18004(a)(2) by the Department for the Institution.

There were 259 students who were eligible to participate in the HEERF II supplemental funding to student under CRRSAA to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1).

The Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSAA were distributed by check to 235 students and by account credit to 24 students.

Section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSAA Financial Aid Grants to students were distributed in 3 tiers with 130 Pell eligible students with an Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) of \$0 receiving \$927 each, 42 Pell eligible students with an EFC of greater than \$0 receiving \$663 each and 87 non-Pell eligible students receiving \$340 each.

Emails were sent to students on March 26, 2021 stating that the grants had been processed and mailed.
