

Embedded Reading Endorsement

Benefits of the Andrew College BSEE degree program include the inclusion of specific reading education courses that will provide you with a P-12 Reading Endorsement. This course for this endorsement will specifically focus on the teaching of reading for students at a variety of levels and within specific disciplines. Teachers will gain practical experience with using both informal and formal reading assessments to guide their instruction.

Reading education coursework embedded into the program includes the following:

RED 467 Teaching Reading (3 hours) This course provides a fundamental framework in teaching reading using specific techniques and strategies. Learners will gain an understanding of both a theoretical and an evidence-based approach to the teaching of the reading.

RED 487 Diagnostic Reading Instruction (3 hours) (Pre-requisite 467) This course instructs P-5 teachers on how to analyze and remediate students' reading strengths and weaknesses by using informal assessment instruments and techniques.

RED 497 Reading Environment (3 hours) (Pre-requisite 487) This course will offer a variety of strategies and practical ideas to support the planning of effective reading and writing instruction in the classroom. Learners will take part in a practicum that provides an opportunity to apply knowledge of reading instruction and assessment in order to increase the reading proficiency of students.
