At Andrew, we break New Student Orientation into two parts: our fall first-week experience and Summer Orientation. During Summer Orientation, you'll handle the items necessary to prepare you for a successful transition to college this fall including meeting classmates, learning important information about Andrew and our programs, and registering for your fall classes.

Deposit

In order to attend Summer Orientation, you need to pay your enrollment deposit (or have it added to your account) by the date of your orientation session. Enrollment deposits may be paid online or by mail when you return your Enrollment Decision form. Deposits will also be accepted the morning of each Summer Orientation session.



Registration for Summer Orientation is easy. Go to the Andrew College website and click on the Student Affairs tab on the home page. That will take you to additional information on the program as well as a link to the registration form. Each orientation session is limited to 20 students. If you register for a session that's full, we will roll your registration to the alternate date you selected on your form.

Campus COVID-19 Protocols

Due to campus Covid-19 restrictions, we ask that the number of people accompanying you to Summer Orientation be limited to no more than 3. All attendees and their families must complete a visitor form and have their temperature taken that morning. The college currently mandates that masks be worn while on campus.

Dual Enrollment Credit

If you have taken Dual Enrollment courses, please make sure that an official transcript from that college is sent to Andrew College once the spring semester is complete. Credit for Dual Enrollment classes will not be awarded based upon high school transcripts.

Advanced Placement Credit

If you have taken AP exams and believe you are eligible for college credit based upon the results, (typically scores of 3,4 or 5), please make sure that AP exam test results are sent to Andrew College.

Academic Advising

All students are assigned to a faculty advisor during Summer Orientation who will assist them in selecting and registering for fall courses.

Depending upon your program of study, you may be reassigned to a permanent faculty advisor once you arrive for the fall semester.

Course Registration

You and your academic advisor will plan your course schedule and register you for classes. Your advisor will have information on the courses that are required for your program of study as well as when those courses will be offered and notifications on whether or not that course section is full and has been closed.

Family Program

While you are going through your summer orientation, we also have a program planned for your family including opportunities to meet faculty and staff members, speak with financial aid and learn more about services and programs available at Andrew.

Parking Decals

Students wishing to park on campus must pay a one-time parking fee of \$25. You can purchase your parking pass during Summer Orientation or when you arrive in the fall. Parking decals are available from the Synergy Campus Security Office on the first floor of Old Main. Cars parking on campus without a parking sticker are subject to a \$25 fine (per violation).

School Store

Andrew College merchandise will be available for purchase that day in case you want to pick up a baseball cap, t-shirt, sweatshirt or pennant.

Paying your Bill

Once you have registered for classes, our student information system (Empower), will generate an Estimated Tuition Worksheet that may be viewed from your Empower account. This worksheet will list the mandatory charges for the semester as well as your financial aid (once you have completed the financial aid process). From this worksheet, you can see and pay your balance for the term.

Tuition Payment Plan

Many Andrew College families sign up for the FACTS plan, which allows them to make monthly payments on their balance. FACT is a private company, and not a part of the college. Although there is an enrollment fee for the program each term, there is no interest charged. However, once the program is set up, it is very important that families adhere to the payment schedule or their ability to use FACTS could be terminated. Move-In Dates

If you are an athlete in a fall sport, you will move in earlier in the month of August. Look for information from your coach this summer regarding the date that you have to report for pre-season training.

If you are NOT participating in a fall sport, your move-in date is Thursday, August 19. Please check your email this summer for information from the Office of Student Affairs regarding move-in and fall orientation.
