Andrew College 1854 COVID-19

- ACADEMIC POLICIES
- Andrew College does NOT require fully vaccinated students to wear masks inside or outside while alone or in the presence of others that are fully vaccinated.
- Andrew College recommends that fully-vaccinated students wear masks inside when in the presence of other students who are not vaccinated or with students whose vaccinated status is unknown. Social distancing is recommended in the dining hall, meeting rooms, and classrooms.
- Andrew College requires students who are not fully vaccinated to wear a cloth face covering or disposable mask within the classroom.
- Faculty have the authority to exclude from the classroom students who are not fully vaccinated yet refuse to wear their masks correctly.
- Andrew College faculty have the choice to accept or decline in-person meetings to students who are not fully vaccinated.
- Certain programs may require students to have COVID-19 vaccinations for full program participation.
- Courses will be delivered in the mode stated on the academic schedule.
- Students and faculty will follow the attendance policy as set forth in the Andrew College Catalog. These policies will be outlined on the syllabus.
- The college has determined classroom capacity after studying suggested social distancing guidelines, and seating is indicated in each room.
- Laboratory and studio classes will be conducted at the instructor's discretion to ensure safe social distancing.
- Faculty members will ask students to enter and to leave the classroom in an orderly fashion.
- Students and faculty are urged to sanitize when entering and leaving a classroom.
- Sanitizing supplies will be available in the classroom buildings. Students may want to bring wipes to sanitize their own space.
- Students are expected to choose one of the designated seats in class the first day, so the faculty
 member will be able to make a chart of the students in their seats to assist with contact tracing
 should a student test positive for COVID-19.
- Students should email their instructors to self-report COVID-19 exposure/symptoms.
