


Students participating in the music program receive training which allows them to pursue a Bachelor of Music with emphases in performance or music education.

Admission

Applying to Andrew College is quick and easy. We prefer that students submit their application electronically through our website, **www.andrewcollege.edu**, but we also accept paper applications.

Required Admission Materials

- Completed application for admission
- Official high school transcripts
- SAT and/or ACT scores (optional)



Provisional Admission

Students who fall below the criteria for regular admission will be evaluated by the Enrollment Management Committee and will be required to participate in either an in-person or a telephone interview.

Transfer Admission

Transfer students who have completed at least 24 semester hours of college coursework do not need to submit high school transcripts as a part of the application process. However, official transcripts from all colleges attended must be provided before an admission decision is finalized.
