Minimum Requirements: Bachelor's degree in healthcare profession from a regionally or nationally accredited college or university; unencumbered healthcare profession licensure; current AHA healthcare provider ACLS, BLS, and PALS certification; two years of full-time clinical experience in the area of teaching responsibility; three years teaching experience in health careers within the last seven years preferred; excellent written and verbal communication skills; ability to work a flexible schedule; must be authorized for unrestricted employment in the United States indefinitely with no immigration sponsorship needed.

Working Conditions: Clinical and classroom environment with minimum lifting (25 pounds) required. Flexible hours to include varying clinical setting shifts/schedules.
