

COVID-19 ACADEMIC POLICIES

- Andrew College requires all students, regardless of vaccination status to wear masks inside campus buildings and practice physical distancing per CDC guidelines. Outdoors, non-vaccinated students are required to wear masks and practice physical distancing. When outside, fully vaccinated students are encouraged to wear masks, although they are **not required** to wear them, and should practice physical distancing.
- Faculty have the authority to exclude from the classroom students who refuse to wear their masks correctly.
- Andrew College faculty have the option to schedule meetings via Zoom or in-person with students.
- Fully vaccinated Andrew College faculty have the choice to teach without a mask if they utilize a plexiglass partition and maintain safe physical distancing. If you are fully vaccinated and choose not to utilize a plexiglass partition, faculty will need to wear a mask and practice physical distancing. Non-vaccinated faculty members will be required to wear a mask and practice physical distancing.
- Certain programs may require students to have COVID-19 vaccinations for full program participation.
- Courses will be delivered in the mode stated on the academic schedule.
- Students and faculty will follow the attendance policy as set forth in the Andrew College Catalog. These policies will be outlined in the syllabus.
- The college has determined classroom capacity after studying suggested physical distancing guidelines, and seating is indicated in each room.
- Laboratory and studio classes will be conducted at the instructor's discretion to ensure safe physical distancing.
- Faculty members will ask students to enter and leave the classroom in an orderly fashion.
- Students and faculty are urged to sanitize when entering and leaving a classroom.
- Sanitizing supplies will be available in the classroom buildings. Students may want to bring wipes to sanitize their own spaces.
- Students are expected to choose one of the designated seats in class on the first day, so the faculty member will be able to make a chart of the students in their seats. Classrooms are set up for safe physical distancing.
- Students should email the Dean of Student of Affairs to self-report COVID exposure/symptoms. The Dean of Student Affairs will communicate to the Academic Dean who will notify faculty when a student is sent home for quarantine/isolation and/or tests positive.
