AFFORDABILITY

Andrew College offers a comprehensive financial assistance program, designed to help students afford the cost of college. Traditionally one of the lowest cost private colleges in Georgia, it is our goal to help make Andrew College a realistic option for all students.

The annual cost of Andrew College for 2022-2023 is \$18,214 for tuition and \$11,728 for room and board. The total annual cost is \$29,428. **There are no mandatory fees of any kind.**
